

Breaking the Siphon on a Fresh Water Tank

On Jayco Motorized Units Only

Fig. A shows the current configuration of the top of the fresh water tank with three vent tubes exiting the top of the tank.

To keep the tank from siphoning, remove one of the lines off at the top of the tank, install a 45 degree elbow pointing upwards, and then connect a short piece of the line (4") to the 45 degree elbow. (Fig. B)

To prevent this hose from forming a kink and restricting air flow, loosely support the line to the floor above. This will allow air to enter the tank from a higher point and break any siphon that is created.



NOTE:

This does not require removing the tank to perform this repair.
